About 3CR

3CR is a dynamic community hub that has produced radio since 1976. Currently we have over 400 volunteers who broadcast and present around 120 radio programs every week, with 20 community language shows in 13 different languages, and 10 hours of Indigenous programming. Listeners can tune in on 855AM, 3CR Digital, stream live, access audio on demand or download podcasts of our shows. 3CR was established in 1976 to provide a voice for those denied access to the mass media, particularly the working class, women, Indigenous people and the many community groups and community issues discriminated against in and by the mass media.

About Music Matters

Music Matters is a 2-hour station program that goes to air on 3CR Friday afternoons from 12 - 2PM. The show covers all things local music with the best gig guide in town. As a Presenter of Music Matters, you'll be joining a team of programmers who are responsible for presenting the program on a rotating roster from 12– 2pm Friday afternoons.
