We're looking for Presenter/s to volunteer on And This One's Introduced By... a music program that features bands/artists introducing their new or retrospective album. As a Presenter of And This One's Introduced By... you'll be responsible for producing, presenting, podcasting and promoting a 1.5hr program from 11 – 12.30am Wednesday evenings or on a rotating roster with a volunteer presenter team. The program is currently being delivered as a pre-recorded show, but you also have the opportunity to present it live.

About 3CR

3CR is a dynamic, community hub that has produced radio since 1976. Currently we have over 400 volunteers who broadcast and present around 120 radio programs every week, with 20 community language shows in 13 different languages, and 10 hours of Indigenous programming. Listeners can tune in on 855AM, 3CR Digital, stream live, access audio on demand or download podcasts of our shows. 3CR was established in 1976 to provide a voice for those denied access to the mass media, particularly the working class, women, Indigenous people and the many community groups and community issues discriminated against in and by the mass media.

About And This One's Introduced By.....

And This One's Introduced By... is a 1.5hour station program that goes to air on 3CR Wednesday evenings from 11pm till 12.30 AM. Each week the program features a different artist/band who introduces the songs from their album or a retrospective of their work. The format is free of a formal interview agenda and gives the artists space to tell their stories.
