Going up that trauma again, and I know Grace times had some mental health struggles since then and my full Good Vibes to you Grace, as someone with an ongoing mental health situation being cyclothymia. I thought if they can speak up with courage and strength and power through as best as they can, I can too. So we have that choice and in terms of the Furnace analogy, when things are going a bit better. Sometimes we can find a fire hose.

If we like and put out the the furnace a bit, so it doesn't flare up or adults harder for it to flare up. And I feel this week that whilst yes, the debate that emerged in the first part of the week was disgusting. There's a few things that need to be said. Congratulations to dr.
