The reason I'm bringing those content notes in is because tomorrow the 20th of November every year is trans day of remembrance and we honour those we have sadly lost due to outright transphobic murders and that is obviously a difficult topic and but I don't think we can really avoid it at this time of year and I try on this show. I would add to balance this sort of positives negatives of trans life. I try to find inspirational trans and Allied people or by for that matter and Allied and all the rest of it. But now we also can't ignore what is going on, you know sort of around the world where I'm grateful that I live here in Melbourne/Naarm in Victoria and to a fair extent Australia and I want to come to that but I also want to talk about today and this is why I want your input is to ask what do we need to do here? You know, the trans Community is full of bright ideas and amazingly creative and talented people and so we do need to you know sort of keep an eye on this and the Trent difficult topic, but the trans murder attempted murder monitoring update was launched about a week ago on the 13th of November and it's sort of talks all about what is going on around the world and look unfortunately 320 reported murders of trans and gender diverse people.

Which is slightly down to 300 from 327 the previous year, but of course, it's a barely a happy State. He's obviously not happy statistic to in any way or degree. And so it's still at a very high level and 235 nine murders in Latin America and the Caribbean and Armenia Belgium and Slovakia reported for the first time this year. So the things that

Mount from the summary and I'll put the link into the podcast but it is trans respect dot-org 94% were trans women but says he or trans feminine and or transfeminine people and that shows immediately the sort of underlying chauvinism misogyny some toxic masculinity that of course dominates transphobia. And really I sometimes think lots of forms of prejudice. It really is just a selfishness that coincide overlap.

So hugely with toxic masculinity globally almost half of murdered trans people with whose occupation was known with sex workers 48 percent and 78% in Europe. So trans people stand in solidarity with all sex workers CIS and trans and we note that next month in December is into on the 17th of December is international day or two. That knowledge is the

National day to in violence against sex workers and that yet the 17th of December for that date. We stand in solidarity with sex workers for more information that is sex work is specific on all sorts of things. You can look at Scarlet Alliance the National Organization here in so-called Australia and Vixen Collective and there are many other good nuns there just to that leap to the top of my mind we then

Go in further trans people affected by racism make up 80% of the reported murders and that's up 15 percent from last year 45% of trans people reported murdered in Europe whose migration background is known were migrants or refugees. So we're getting a huge sort of idea of the disproportionate nature of transphobic violence 19 to 25 year olds most at risk. And so this is why parental support is important and family.

Original I'll use the term family of origin support and of cases with age data available 3/4 between 19 and 40 years old. So are you certainly are vulnerable again Latin America and the Caribbean Brazil not good, obviously the right influence of far right-wing people. They're not helping and guns a big problem as we know and the streets.

Scent and homes 26% So let's get away from ideas about don't you know, go so similar things there to assist women and what's this women plot faced in terms of violence. So lots of things and this now sort of of course, this is where we can get reporting where there are lots of places. We're not going to get the data. There's not people on the ground willing and and or able to report it and so, you know, lots of things

Consider there and it's knowledge that there are established monitoring systems in Latin America and the Caribbean and now I mentioned that at the you know, I'm very grateful that I live in Australia. And you know, I look I don't it's now one of those things that you know, we haven't it's sort of always I've always feel very mixed when I

Say Australia so-called Australia hasn't reported any known murders of trans people this year. It's like well, why should we even have to say that there should be no known murders of trans people anywhere. And of course, we don't know exactly there's not a lot of monitoring say an F on the continent of Africa and countries there in which can limit things as well. And so we know it's not enough to say

Or you're not being murdered and this is one of the things that right-wing types will do to us that all you're not being murdered is if that was I supposed to be grateful and fall on our knees for that. Well, no, we have a right as trans people at all people do to live our lives as our authentic selves as part of

the whole in every way to achieve our potential to be happy and healthy in every way and we'll 370 people this year 320. Sorry are

Not with us anymore to do that and they are in our hearts and our minds at this time, and it's certainly something that we need to consider and we had a couple of messages in so, you know sort of come back to those after the next track and the next track without underwear.

An affirming what I've just spoken about comes from the fact that we do need to be ourselves. We have a right to be ourselves and that we can be and this is one of my old favorites from the trickles. I think there's lots of people wanting to do the right thing and I'm a big

Big big believer in this that you know, yes, there's a lot of noise and yes, there are you know, obviously concerns and yes all of us but including queer people in the inner and just beyond the inner suburbs I call myself in the middle of Suburbia where I live are also concerned about cost of living. I'll be very Frank with you for a few days this week. I had zero money in my savings account and the credit card was it

Full limit so I've got cost of living pressures to Jenny. So it's about how do we put it all together? And I think we can so I think that is possible to do that because if we treat people with respect and people are not in poverty because of who they are then maybe that's going to ease some cost of living pressures. That's just one thought and that's very off the cuff. So to speak all them wearing short sleeves. So maybe I don't have any cuffs. Seriously. I think that we can just come at this with basics of

Ian and kindness and now I think that outer suburbs Regional rural Victoria and then as much as I can speak Beyond Victoria, I mean living by my own principles, can I speak for what's happening in the rest of the country not with as much Authority I suppose but it going to be differences regionally. And this was one of the things that pride in the north talked about was that we now need to

Be drilling into some extent for differences in local regions. So maybe there are some but now as someone who has a say who lives in what I call middle suburbs. What do I need to do to understand those differences if I'm you know, where I am. So I think they're Fair thoughts Jenny, but I think we we there are differences. But also it's about holding space for what we might have in common as well as

Just thinking about differences and let's sort of as I say hold space for both. Yeah. What else can we do this? This is the ideas. We want, you know to get this thinking because of course in this week of trans awareness week. Also, we had the out in the open Festival up in Shepherd and and unfortunately another well, I'll say advertised drag event had to be cancelled in a pop-up event and well done to the rainbow and

Jules for being on the job but we shouldn't need rainbow Angels either. I think it's a sad statement that we have. No, we need rainbow angels and I think we need now. Some people won't say this but police are supposed to defend Law and Order and the drag events are lawful events and yet threats stop them going ahead. I've said this before and I'll say it again and I can say this as someone who is to use my term culturally Jewish, but

Of the Jewish faith to a small extent if these threats were happening against synagogues police would be all over it. And I don't think it's good enough that police are letting those people get away with it. And the people making the threats need to be charged. Yeah, they are, you know, they're not there's got to be something going wrong here. I don't know. I'm not a lawyer. I don't know what law specifically people making threats are breaking if they're doing it online. Is that misuse of an electronic device or something? That would be a start.

And point in my book, but it just simply cannot go on this way that these things still keep happening. So, you know, I think we need to start asking police. Why are they not doing more than by saying just cancel? Are they really looking after their own interests? Because I don't want to deploy police there. Well police with respect your there to look after the public in accordance with the law and the the VIN majority victorians do not

I want in my opinion lawful events cancelled in this way. So there's some strong opinions, but it might need some strong allyship to stand up against this sort of thing because you give extremists a MM they'll take in Earth's circumference and it's not good enough that they're not being slapped down hard metaphorically speaking and they're continuing to get away with this. So there's some thoughts for everyone. Welcome your thoughts.

Back and let's say I'm have some constructive conversations. We need every Ally ship we can get here that is peaceful and respectful and stands up for safety and those sorts of things which is a perfect lead-in totally unintended. And of course we seems there's a new variant out there on covid which is a little scary. So keep up to date with your vaccinations that can certainly help reduce the possibility of

Transmission and spread if you can if you are so if that's what you need if you can get vaccinated, of course that is yeah. Than average citizens. And so they have to use it wisely is my thing on police. And I also think personally there needs to be an investigation into far-right influence in police force right-wing influence in police forces around the country and other establishment Powers. I know after what happened in March this year, which we haven't forgotten and I don't think we can ignore in the context of today's show.

Why hasn't that happened? Kylee has messaged me to serve asked him. Peace while the thugs haven't been charged but no answer. Hmm, you know, well that you know, I think that's a fair question Kaelyn. Yeah, and I think that there is this systemic toxic masculinity police may be based on Military hierarchy, you know, that's not the answer to dealing with community and it's about how we make our police more adaptable to

Relations, they don't just come at it from a that. I'm being deliberately exaggerated here are chest-thumping Law and Order approach 99% of the people police are going to deal with are the public and no say I don't know 80 percent of those people are innocent citizens and 19% civil offenders. Yes, they're doing 68 and 60s our own or whatever it is or the point 0 5 1 and that's not appropriate sure, but you can still now and be civil to people.

You don't have to sort of you know, sort of metaphorically stand over people in that way. I think is the answer here. I'm not just thinking about you know, it's going to build more more good than just, you know, this idea that you strike fear into innocent people. That just doesn't make sense to me. Yeah, but also just to mention some of the other things while I've before I forget that came up,
