But as we left in the late afternoon heading into early evening on that Summers Night, there was a booze bus setup and now there was all these, I will use the term trans women and non-binary, gender non-conforming people, regardless of label going through, now this was the late 90s from memory about

Nineteen ninety eight ish, and apparently, one of our number after they went through, heard one police officer say to the other, that's the six. Bloody you want to lose people already? What's going on now? That is not in itself funny but the fact that they got some sort of surprise, I think is a positive experience for queer visibility, which just had a bit of fun. I don't honestly don't believe there was any real discrimination in that can argue about it.

And of course, under law, I would hasten to add, I'll come to that in a short time discrimination. Doesn't matter how you mean it. Otherwise we'd never have any discrimination or it'd be impossible to prove that sort of thing. May is probably a bit conservative. I'd say, highly likely and some doctors are quote ill equipped to care for transpeople partly to structural stigmatization built into medical training, which is

Assumes. I'm going to say cisgender and probably Endo sex bodies and the authors of this piece, I ring doll and a GP in clinical editor with health Pathways Western Australia and misgendering occurs, when a person is addressed or described. Using language name, pronouns or title that does not match their gender identity. 29% of trans young people, avoided Medical Services due to gender nonconformity.

That's I think we would like, don't know if there's research on all ages, because certainly older people who have had a greater length of time of marginalization, and probably at least on balance the same degree, you know, it would probably that needs to be considered language used. There's structural interpersonal and individual stigma. So structural intention and unintentional.

Policies, and practices that result in restricted opportunities for stigmatized people. Now, it should be noted, something very important that under anti-discrimination protections that exist at a national level and in all states and territories, including for Trans and gender diverse people. For example, Victorian law section, 10 says, motive is irrelevant. So it doesn't matter whether it's intentional and for that matter, it doesn't even have to be unconscious bias, according to a recent, a relatively recent case,

So structural stigma that contributes to lack of education and interpersonal and individual. Well I'll just say from most of my experience and what I've heard firsthand most of this stuff seems to happen when a trans person is buying them self and even worse. When there's two other people from a service provider in the immediate space and there's a sort of even if there's not, there's a gang up because one

The service provider service provider person. Number one goes and tells number two. Person number two, probably gives an at least uninformed. If not, not objective assessment and on we go and there's also incomplete data in health care data collection, bathrooms water, allocation, and structural policy. So a lot of things. So I really appreciate

I'll say correspondent sending in this, in this, these comments. Now, here's where we really have to, unfortunately, ramp up the level of what happened. And this person says they have experienced medicalized gendered violence. IE. Where medicine is

Is weaponized to cause harm. And the person correspondent went for a care plan. In the outer West, with a nurse, the correspondent says, I'm a trans man. A cisgender woman nurse started by being late and hurried me out because it was 4:40 p.m. yep. Well, the thing is any client needs to get the same service.

That what, no matter what time of day or night it is, or let's say, get the best quality service with the best. Quality outcomes would be a better way to put it because we all know we don't want to be treated the same. We wouldn't we all need the same outcome. The person has gender affirming care as part of their care. Planning, the nurse said to the trans man that they done the rainbow tick accreditation a few years ago and the trainer I'd better say I had allegedly said if you treat me poorly,

Leo, I'll just Sue and get a holiday to Barley. Now, I don't think any diversity trainer in there right. It who is worth their salt would say that but clearly if it did then that's inappropriate but I don't think anyone really needs to listen to that. Then the nurse asks the transman about Ghana logical Health, instead of asking me, if I'd had a pap smear or breast, but a breast exam then we'll raise the content.

That nurse asks, do you still have memories? Well just call them breasts when discussing go on a logical issues that needed attending to that only matters if you are having deep penetrative sex. So that's well the I can't think how many parts of federal and state into in anti-discrimination law, that breaks the issue has nothing to do with the sex life.

The second cisgender woman nurse and the nurse who did the care plan? Did I closed or consultation about me before the injection? Yeah. Well, we all know about that, that, you know, they can say this thing's on record on film, but it's what's said behind closed doors. It was raised with the complaint in the clinic manager launched a fuss about in launching an investigation, but was dismissive.

And wrote. And so the trans man has asked for medical records and said, would be leaving the clinic for good. The records came in, the care plan is horribly prioritized and it seems I'm employed without consent. It seems to me without the client, the patient's consent, which is totally inappropriate. I'm towards other, physical health issues that were not even discussed in the

And I left out gender affirming Carol together. It's also got a whole lot, lot of misleading information about my health status. I've asked for the care plan to be removed under the Australian privacy principles. You are allowed to correct medical information. And I suggest people get to know the Australian privacy principles around this because misleading information or attempts to make you comply. Can follow you hmm hope that helps. Yeah. Wow zzz.

Goodness, goodness me. I mean, I'm

Gobsmacked to say that put it mildly. I'm sure there's probably other situations like that. Yeah, how someone can possibly write up your medical plan without your consent and then not tell you is beyond me.

I mean, you know, one-sided all that sort of thing. I mean yes as as our listeners can no doubt here, I'm somewhat. Yeah. Athlete bewildered by this that could happen that someone could actually write up something that's not a great to. I mean, I am not. I'll say this in a lay sense of the word, not any legal sense. I'm wondering, if that's fraud or forgery or intention to commit Proto forgery, given that it's happened. It's probably stronger than intention using these words in Lay terms. But wow, that's appalling. And we need to get these issues out there. I don't think

there's enough understanding amongst the broader cis population of what trans and gender diverse people experience, experiencing so, thank you, correspondent for sending that information. And I had not honor your

Courage authenticity and similar positive qualities in doing so. And if anyone is listening is distressed by that. Once again, to play ultra-safe Q life, including switchboard in Victoria and Tasmania 1-800 1845 to seven rainbow door. One eight hundred seven to nine three six seven. Yeah, absolutely bewildering. But as I say,

I just wonder how much of this is going on and 3 CR is here to talk about these sorts of issues. So now again, if you've had an experience, you feel comfortable to share that he's - with a service provider and employment. Please let me know. Also, particularly the timing is important. And I'd note again strongly correspondent comment that this happened just after the Certain National Press Club conference. So, this certainly, you know, that there's evidence that this obviously has a negative influence on people that they think they can probably just break laws and get away with it. Pretty woeful.
