It will give us that information will find out exactly where people live, will we get exact numbers? I mean, let's look at something. There will be and I'll just start with the book. I'll call it in simple terms, the adults age bracket, some people might not be willing to disclose still living.

The proverbial in stealth for in hiding. Some people might you might be afraid to for whatever reason but I think that the privacy concerns are being reasonably well addressed. And if you are someone in a shared house hold and you can you want to get your own particular form? You can do that. So I think that's incredibly welcome and the questions on sex and gender from a trans and gender diverse.

Active are good but well with apologies to make Life 2 out of 6 is bad because for anyone under 16 they can't cannot disclose sexual orientation and gender identity. Gee, I wonder if someone was worried about fundamentalist Christians and you know influencing the government on our we can't be influencing the children in Yahoo's. Keeps looking after the children.

Children. Well, we won't be in this country for another five years. If we don't count sexual orientation and gender identity of children. And I just think it was really poor that that was left out. But even poorer in, my opinion is what's happened with people with variation of sex characteristics, not included at all. And this is what I really wanted to focus on. I will say, I've heard it differing opinions on why it didn't happen. I've heard

Heard some statistical type so they couldn't get a question that would be answered will say without without enough without significant variation of statistical variation because of the wording. Now, I am a person of who is endo enti sex as far as I know. My sex characteristics, fit expectation fitted expectations for me assigned male at Birth and I'm just, you know, so I'm going to do my best to be an ally, but looking at the website for interaction, the national body for health and human rights in Australia for for people, with variation of sex characteristics. And just trying

To get to the exact page now to get the definition that they use for intersex. And

They have sort of used in one part of their website, excuse me. They've sort of said that people knowing that they would knowing they were born with variation of sex characteristics. And that's really important. And so, and the think that the critical factor is

Born now no one should have to prove themselves. We don't ask Endo sex people to prove themselves. We don't ask people whose gender identity fits societal expectations in a sip. I'm using something very quick and dirty there with my definition for gender identity and we're going are cisgender people to prove himself. We don't ask heterosexual people to prove themselves but the thing is people with variation of sex characteristics know. They're, they're your chromosomes and genes obviously are there from birth and if you therefore have an identifiable variation of sex characteristics, whether genetic chromosomal or whether it was visible bodily, variation it intersects so I don't understand why it was so hard to get the right definition. Now, I know that in the past, there have been some people who are wanting to be careful here or who many People might classify put under trans but also end, 06 have said no, my being trans is a variation of sex characteristics. Now I respect that the right to that opinion but you know it hasn't unfortunately mean proven, as much as I hate, that is yet. And you don't know, you're born with it, I'm mostly most likely are we? Of course we don't become trans any more than we suddenly become in terms of sexual orientation, gay lesbian or bisexual

Actual but I think definition that says something like a known born with a known variation of sex. Characteristics could have worked and therefore, I can't buy into these statistical variation within the other allegation. I've heard is that there was the proverbial Captain's call by Rover by prime minister, Anthony Albanese e. And I don't think that's good enough either. I have heard repeatedly that Anthony Albanese he I've heard from a kind of set, least two sources that Albanese. He stopped learning about the rainbow communities around 2003 and from a very conservative people who sort of didn't really go past gay and lesbian, which is why many people believe at times groups like trans and intersex and to some extent by plus and Ace have been ignored by the Prime Minister and I don't think that's good enough that it came down to him now. The thing is, you could say, well, now there's a saying, what you can, what can you do about? The things that are in your control. I am quite confident that people with variation of sex characteristics. Including obviously people from interaction, would have advocated very, very hard for intersex inclusion. We know they did. So, what broke down, is there a problem with our lobbying do? We not only have a very few limited people from Rainbow communities, who are getting access to keep

People in government and public sector. Are we having Endo sex people trying to for do the definition? I don't know that the answers to that, maybe we'll find out some more as time goes on, but I think I can want to say most of all. I totally affirm the absolute disappointment sadness, frustration and other feelings of people with variation of sex characteristics, that they're not being counted in the census.

It is really quite disconcerting that that is the case, and not good enough. And there's a breakdown somewhere between people with variation of sex characteristics. And their good advocacy, which I honestly saved people with their variation of sex characteristics. Do very, very well. And the fact that this information is not getting up to the top levels of national government. And when you look at the answers that have been made by people with variation of sex characteristics, such as the ACT Lords of 2023 in the Victorian ones of this year. Yeah, you can get through to government and it can happen that stone, you know, those two states and territories and we've got six more to go. Where intersex is being viewed. Somewhat favorably. Well as they say Houston we have a problem. How we solve it, I don't know.

But I'd love to find out if there are people in the know with variation of sex characteristics, love to hear from you and complimenting.
